## PROPERLY MAINTAINING AND CLEANING YOUR HARD HAT

This guide addresses maintenance of hard hats once they enter usage, helping to ensure that they will continue to provide proper protection over their lifespan.

### Periodic Cleaning



When a more thorough cleaning is required, disassemble your hard hat and hand-wash all components with water mixed with a mild soap. Use a wet cloth to scrub, if necessary. Avoid harsh disinfectants, solvents, or chemical cleaners as they could negatively affect the components, causing a reduction in protection.

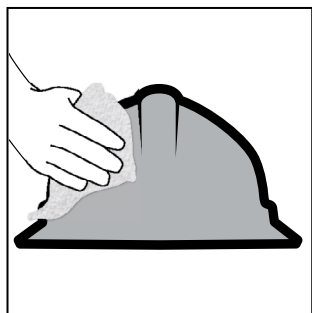


Rinse with clean water. Hand dry components with a soft cloth, and air dry the suspension and sweatband.



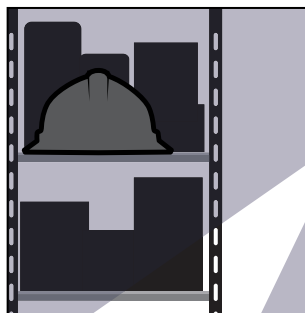
Reassemble and you're ready for your next shift. If necessary, a hard hat and all components can be used when wet. The drying step is for comfort, not functionality.

### Daily Cleaning



Regular cleaning and maintenance will help ensure that your hard hat can do its job properly. At the end of a shift your hard hat should be wiped down with a dry cloth, inside and out, to remove any contaminants present.

### Storage



When not in use, your hard hat should be stored in a clean, dry location that is not subject to extreme temperatures, humidity, or direct sunlight.
